Speak this confession prayer every day, believing God with great expectation to make provision and bring prosperity into your life.

Heavenly Father, this sacrificial offering represents the first of my labor for 2010 and all of my increase. It represents my best. I offer it unto You as part of my worship. With this offering, I acknowledge that You, and only You, are my source. I bring it to the man of God to be used for the work of Your kingdom. It is over and above my tithes and offerings.
