

## Barrenness

*A Healing Prayer for a Barren Woman Who Wants to Have a Child*

**Healing Promise:** “He settles the barren woman in her home as a happy mother of children. Praise the Lord” (Ps. 113:9, NKJV).

**Healing Prayer:** Father, I ask you to confirm your Word to me by settling me in my home as the happy mother of children.<sup>1</sup> I believe the promise of your Word which loudly declares to me that you will give me the desires of my heart.<sup>2</sup> Dear God, to have a child is a great desire of my heart, and I believe you will answer my prayer for a child. Thank you, Father.

Truly, your Word imparts faith to my heart.<sup>3</sup> In fact, I believe you are able to do exceedingly abundantly beyond all I can ask or think, according to your power which is at work in me by your Spirit.<sup>4</sup> Hallelujah!

I rest in your exceedingly great and precious promises, Father.<sup>5</sup> I know that nothing is too hard for you.<sup>6</sup> Therefore, I ask you now for a baby, because I know that you are able to perform the same kind of miracle in my life that you did for barren women in the Bible.

Thank you for all that you are teaching me as I wait before you. Your way is perfect, O God,<sup>7</sup> and you enable me to mount up with wings like an eagle, as I wait before you.<sup>8</sup> Without any reservation, therefore, I will trust in you with all my heart. I choose not to lean toward my own understanding. Instead, I will acknowledge you in all my ways, and I know you will direct my paths.<sup>9</sup> Thank you for hearing and answering my prayer, dear Father.

Your plans for me are so wonderful – to give me a future and a hope.<sup>10</sup> I claim your promise now as great hope fills my heart with joy. Because your lovingkindness is better than life to me, my lips shall praise you. Thus will I bless you, Father. I will lift up my hands in your name. Thank you for satisfying my soul in every way. My mouth shall praise you with joyful lips.<sup>11</sup>

I look forward to welcoming the child you are giving to me. I dedicate myself to raising this child in the nurture and admonition of you, Lord God.<sup>12</sup> Thank you, Father, for your wonderful love and care. In the wonderful name of Jesus I pray, Amen.<sup>13</sup>
