



PRAYER FOR REUNITING WITH MISSING LOVED ONES

Key Scripture: *For the Son of Man came to find and restore the lost* (Luke 19:10, MSG).

Key Thought: God greatly values every soul. He is concerned about missing persons and will stop at nothing to ensure their recovery.

Heavenly Father, I thank You that You know us by name and that every person is precious and valuable in Your eyes (*Isaiah 40:26*). I just learned that my loved one _____ is missing. I pour out my heart like water in Your presence (*Lamentations 2:19*), and I ask You, in Your infinite grace and mercy, to keep him/her safe until we are reunited.

I praise You, Lord, that Your eyes are in every place, and You know my loved one's whereabouts (*Proverbs 15:3*). I call upon Your perfect wisdom to guide my loved one back home (*James 1:5*). Just as You wait patiently with open arms and loving compassion to restore us when we return to You, I also wait patiently for the safe return of my loved one. I cast down fearful thoughts, for You have not given me a spirit of fear, but of power, and of love, and of a sound mind (*2 Timothy 1:7*). Thank You for ensuring my loved one's complete safety and protection (*Psalms 91*).

Lord, You said that You are with us, and You watch over us wherever we go (*Genesis 28:15*). Thank You for being with my loved one and watching over him/her until You reunite us and bring us back together. We do not have to be afraid or discouraged, because You will never leave us nor forsake us (*Deuteronomy 31:8*).

Lord, Your perfect love casts out all fear and ensures my loved one's safety and wellbeing (*1 John 4:18*). In the presence of Your light, there is no darkness (*1 John 1:5*). No one can be threatened, in danger, or harmed when they are surrounded by the light and protection of Your love.

Thank You, Lord, for Your peace and certainty of a favorable outcome. All things are working for the good of my loved one who loves You and is called according to Your purpose (*Romans 8:28*). I praise You for Your peace that passes all understanding to guard my heart and mind (*Philippians 4:7*). I place my loved one in Your capable hands, and I trust with all my heart that they are safe and secure. Thank You in advance for their safe and immediate return. Let Your will be done in their lives (*Matthew 6:10*). In Jesus' name I pray, Amen.
